St Leonards School in St Andrews is fully co-educational and welcomes pupils from the ages of 4 1/2 to 19, with the option of boarding from the age of 12. The school occupies its own campus in a prominent position on the edge of St Andrews, a thriving and charming university town on the Fife coast. St Andrews is an hour's drive from Edinburgh or 90 minutes from Glasgow, both of which have international airports, therefore putting the School within two hours of London.

UK high school education takes 4 years. During the first 2 years students study for **GCSE** exams and during the second 2 years they can either prepare for the **IB Diploma** or for **A- levels** - the qualifications which are the most common methods used to enter British universities. Instead of taking A Levels/IB Diploma, some students choose to enroll in a University Foundation Course- a one-year course during which students study subjects in a desired area.

Academic programmes

- **GCSE (14-16) - The General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE)** is an academic qualification taken by students aged 14–16 and final examinations are taken at the end of Year 11 (age 15–16).
- **IB Diploma (16-19)** - a two-year programme for students aged 16 and above preparing for university entry.

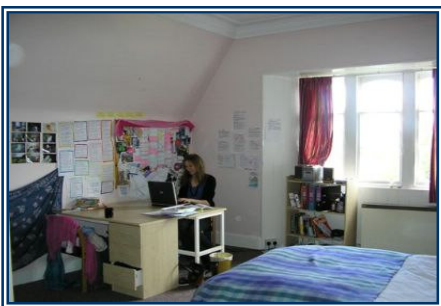

Admissions

- **Senior** - Entrance Examination - candidates sit papers in English and Maths;
- **Sixth Form** – students are expected to have gained six GCSEs at grade C or above, or equivalent qualifications. Overseas students may be required to sit St Leonards own tests if they have not followed a GCSE course or equivalent. Students for whom English is not their first language are expected to have obtained a standard of English equivalent to the Cambridge First Certificate or IELTS academic grade 6.
